


## All Saints' Church, Ascot Heath

### REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE INTERMENT OF CREMATED REMAINS IN THE CHURCHYARD

1. Applications for interment of cremated remains of those persons entitled to be buried in the churchyard may be made to the Incumbent.
2. The right of interment is normally given where a person was resident in the parish at the time of death, was previously resident in parish, or worships regularly at All Saints Church.
3. The interment of cremated remains should be by committal directly to earth, by pouring the uncontained remains into a hole in the ground then covering them with earth.
4. The locally disturbed area will be levelled and re-turfed with grass.
5. No marker will be put in place at the site of committal, either temporary or permanent.
6. Plastic flowers and containers for flowers or plants are not permitted in the area set aside by faculty. Flowers may be placed in the area at the time of committal and remain for a period of not more than one month after.
7. All Saints' Parochial Church Council is responsible for the maintenance of the area.
8. Families may commemorate the occasion, by an entry in a book of remembrance, which will be on public display inside the church.
9. No order for an entry in the book of remembrance may be placed until a full description is submitted to the Incumbent.
10. The wording in the book of remembrance must be simple and reverent, and may include felicitous quotation from literary sources
11. The fees for interment shall be those currently in force within the Church of England, and displayed on a notice board in the church.
12. Any queries or problems that arise from the interpretation of these regulations will be subject to decision by the Incumbent, who will in the event of disagreement, refer such matters to the Chancellor.
13. Amendments to these regulations may be made only by majority vote of the Parochial Church Council, albeit, then only in accordance with faculty jurisdiction.
